Subject: Changes in Duties at entry for ALL products (implementation of Social Welfare Surcharge)

To whom it may concern

The budget 2018-2019 brought some changes that can be of importance to our Belgian exporters.

Main change in duties at import

In the budget 2018-2019 it was decided to abolish the Education Cess and the Higher Education Cess. It has been replaced by Social Welfare Surcharge.

The Education Cess was a duty of 2% calculated on the Basic Customs Duty.

The Secondary and Higher Education Cress was a duty of 1% calculated on the Basic Customs Duty.

The new Social Welfare Surcharge is 10% calculated in the Basic Customs Duty.

This is an **increase of 6.3** % of the total duties to be paid at import(GST included)

Specific change in duties at import

Some changes in duties were also implemented since 01/02/2018
